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- Western Regional Resource List ([www.wrri.us](http://www.wrri.us))
  - Strong end-user input
    - Results in the development of the right tool
  - Agreement of the user group on common data
    - Results in consistency
  - Value-added attracts more users
  - Manage expectations
    - Attempting to build a system that is “all things to all people” usually results in the system being “nothing to anybody”
    - Limit “scope creep” and drifting focus

# Challenges

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- Stay Involved
  - Provide input and feedback
  - Use it before the balloon goes up
- Things Change
  - Contrast “Needs” vs. “bells & whistles”
    - (K.I.S.S)

# Keys To Success

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- Honor ICS structure & vocabulary
  - “Value-Added” functionality
  - Adopt existing methodologies where possible
  - Balance framework with flexibility
    - Accommodate unique requirements
    - Use expanding forms (example; if MD present, display MD data form)
  - Use terminology that ICS staff understands
- Build consensus (buy-in)

  - Assess benefits vs. burdens
