 - Strong end-user input
 - Results in the development of the right tool
 - Agreement of the user group on common data
 - Results in consistency
 - Value-added attracts more users
 - Manage expectations
 - Attempting to build a system that is "all things to all people" usually results in the system being "nothing to anybody"
 - Limit "scope creep" and drifting focus



Challenges

Keys To Success

- Honor ICS structure & vocabulary
